- Communicate effectively with RN Case Manager and ability to take direction from RN Case Manager and other team members
- Maintains accurate and complete records of observations, treatments and care of patients
- Attend team conferences and all meetings required
- Participate in the on-call rotation and maintain responsibility for on call coverage at all times assigned
- Prepare clinical and progress notes and maintain medical record per Hospice policy
- Assist the physician and RN in performing specialized procedures
- Assist Case Managers in monitoring and guiding Hospice Aides
